

Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Coding Course

Prerequisites: Completion of a professional coding course, or 1 year of Professional Fee coding experience recommended.

Clock Hours: 8 hours

Training Description:

This online course is designed for coding professionals working in, or interested in the Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PMR) coding specialties. Students will learn coding for physical and occupational therapy evaluations. This certificate course also includes ICD-10-CM, Evaluation and Management, and CPT coding for physical medicine services. Cases studies are included for practical application.

Training Objectives:

1. Learn guidelines and how to assign codes for provider evaluations in physical therapy.
2. Learn guidelines and how to assign codes for provider evaluations in occupational therapy.
3. Review ICD-10-CM guidelines and common diagnoses for PMR specialties.
4. Review Evaluation and Management coding for PMR.
5. Discuss application of most frequently used CPT® codes and modifiers.
6. Supply hands-on examples and review material to improve your mastery of the above concepts.

Training Content:
